Departmental Reports

Chief Irizarry gave a report on the Muttontown Police Department and gave the report for the month of February 2026.

Mayor Liguori asked Acting Clerk Joe Russo to give a treasurer's report for the month ending February 2026. Acting Clerk Russo discussed the bank reconciliation data from village statements ending January 31, 2026 through statement end date February 28, 2026.

Resolution 26-22 – A motion was made by Deputy Mayor Prasad, seconded by Trustee Economou and carried unanimously to waive the reading of the prior meetings minutes.

Resolution 26-23 – A motion was made by Trustee Scialli seconded by Trustee Economou and carried unanimously to approve the February 11, 2026 regular meetings minutes.

Resolution 26-24 – A motion was made by Trustee Singh and seconded by Trustee Schloss and carried unanimously to approve the February 11, 2026 executive meeting's minutes.

Resolution 26-25 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Scialli and carried unanimously to approve adjustment to resolution 25-121 warrant total to decrease the total amount by \$25.00 for a new total of \$1,693,364.99.

Resolution 26-26 – A motion was made by Deputy Mayor Prasad and seconded by Trustee Singh and carried unanimously to approve warrants which have been audited by a majority of the Board of Trustees and are hereby offered for approval by the Board of Trustees and authorize the Clerk/Treasurer to process said payments.

Resolution 26-28 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Singh and carried unanimously to set Friday April 3, 2026 as the lien sale date for parcels within the Village of Muttontown and that the Village will bid on and hold all tax liens.

Resolution 26-33 – A motion was made by Trustee Scialli and seconded by Deputy Mayor Prasad and carried unanimously to approve the Harris Beach Murtha proposal for Election Day legal services dated February 10, 2025 at the rate of \$5,250.

Resolution 26-34 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Schloss and carried unanimously to approve the Harris Beach Murtha proposal for general legal representation dated February 10, 2025 at the rate of \$6,250 monthly.
