Call to Order

The meeting of the Incorporated Village of Muttontown was called to order by Mayor James Liguori, at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge to the Flag of the United States of America was recited by the Board, Village personnel, residents and the general public.

Departmental Reports

Chief Irizarry gave a report on the Muttontown Police Department and gave the report for the month of March 2026.

Mayor Liguori asked Acting Clerk Joe Russo to give a treasurer's report for the month ending March 2026. Acting Clerk Russo discussed the bank reconciliation data from village statements ending February 28, 2026 through statement end date March 31, 2026.

At 7:05 p.m. Deputy Mayor Prasad moved to open the public hearing on the 2026/2027 Tentative Budget, which was seconded by Trustee Economou and unanimously approved.

There being no comments, Trustee Economou moved to close the public hearing at 7:12p.m. which was seconded by Trustee Singh and unanimously approved.

At 7:15 p.m. Trustee Economou moved to open the public hearing on Local Law 2 of 2026, a local law to amend the Village Code Chapter 190, Article IV to add § 190-15 Short Term Rental Permits, which was seconded by Deputy Mayor Prasad and unanimously approved.

Village Attorney Keith Corbett gave an overview of the proposed Local Law.

Mayor Liguori asked for any comments from the Board or the public.

There being no comments, Trustee Schloss moved to adjourn and hold the public hearing open at 7:24p.m. which was seconded by Trustee Singh and unanimously approved.

Resolution 26-44 – A motion was made by Trustee Schloss and seconded by Trustee Economou and carried unanimously to Set Village Hall as the polling place for the Village election to be held on June 16, 2026 with polls open from 8:00am-9:00pm.

Resolution 26-45 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Singh and carried unanimously to appoint election inspectors for the Village Election on June 16, 2026: Poll Coordinator David Grumer at the rate of \$250.00
Inspectors Frank Palazolo, Jayne McPartlin and Mike Haft at the rate of \$200.00

Resolution 26-46 – A motion was made by Trustee Scialli and seconded by Deputy Mayor Prasad and carried unanimously to authorize Mayor Liguori to sign the Memorandum of Agreement with the Nassau County Board of Elections for the use of voting machines.

Resolution 26-47 – A motion was made by Deputy Mayor Prasad and seconded by Trustee Schloss and carried unanimously to approve adjustment to resolution 26-26 warrant total to increase the total amount by \$1,550.95 for a new total of \$505,405.22.

Resolution 26-48 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Singh and carried unanimously to Surplus Muttontown Police Vehicle and approve sale of the vehicle at auction with VIN number 1FM5K8AB7LGA98207.
