Call to Order

The meeting of the Incorporated Village of Muttontown was called to order by Mayor James Liguori, at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge to the Flag of the United States of America was recited by the Board, Village personnel, residents and the general public.

Departmental Reports

Chief Irizarry gave a report on the Muttontown Police Department and gave the report for the month of April 2026.

Mayor Liguori asked Acting Clerk Joe Russo to give a treasurer's report for the month ending April 2026. Acting Clerk Russo discussed the bank reconciliation data from village statements ending March 31, 2026 through statement end date April 30, 2026.

New Business

Resolution 26-49 – A motion was made by Deputy Mayor Prasad, seconded by Trustee Economou and carried unanimously to waive the reading of the prior meetings minutes.

Resolution 26-50 – A motion was made by Trustee Scialli seconded by Trustee Fagen and carried unanimously to approve the April 15, 2026 regular meetings minutes.

Resolution 26-51 – A motion was made by Trustee Fagen and seconded by Trustee Scialli and carried unanimously to approve the April 15, 2026 executive meeting’s minutes.

Resolution 26-52 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Scialli and carried unanimously to approve the return of escrow funds as follows:

Aldo Calabrese \$808.75

Julia Riviezzo \$8,290.67

Resolution 26-53 – A motion was made by Deputy Mayor Prasad and seconded by Trustee Fagen and carried unanimously to approve warrants which have been audited by a majority of the Board of Trustees and are hereby offered for approval by the Board of Trustees and authorize the Clerk/Treasurer to process said payments.

Resolution 26-54 – A motion was made by Trustee Scialli and seconded by Trustee Economou and carried unanimously to update resolution 26-47, which updated 26-26, to reduce total by \$173.08 for a new warrant total of \$505,232.14.

Resolution 26-55 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Fagen and carried unanimously to Direct Clerk-Treasurer Joe Russo to receive and collect from the persons named in the tax roll a total sum of \$4,055,438.00, consisting of \$3,690,989.00 Property Tax Levy and East Norwich Fire Levy of \$364,449.00 for taxpayers in the East Norwich Fire Protection area, without additional charges, between the 1st day of June 2026 and the 1st day of July 2026.

Resolution 26-56 – A motion was made by Trustee Scialli and seconded by Deputy Mayor Prasad and carried unanimously to approve the assignment for an apportioned property as follows: Section 15 Block 48 Lot 12 as 1935 Muttontown/Eastwoods Road and Section 15 Block 48 Lot 48 as 1933 Muttontown/ Eastwoods Road.

Resolution 26-57 – A motion was made by Deputy Mayor Prasad and seconded by Trustee Fagen and carried unanimously to designate as an additional Official Bank Depository, OceanFirst Bank, N.A.

Resolution 26-58 – A motion was made by Trustee Economou and seconded by Trustee Scialli and carried unanimously to appoint to the Zoning Board Lindsay Milchheim as an alternate member for a term to expire the first Monday in July 2026.

At 7:05 p.m. Trustee Economou moved to open the public hearing for tree removal at 10 Bromley Court, Muttontown, known as Section 15 Block 206 Lot 61A and 61B, which was seconded by Deputy Mayor Prasad and unanimously approved.

Mayor Liguori asked for any comments from the Board or the public. The applicant’s representative Pete Worrell presented on the proposal.

There being no comments, Trustee Economou moved to close the public hearing at 7:11p.m. which was seconded by Deputy Mayor Prasad and unanimously approved.

Resolution 26-59 – A motion was made by Trustee Fagen, seconded by Trustee Scialli and carried unanimously to approve the removal of 94 trees and as a condition of approval a tree remediation plan approved by the Building Department and an escrow deposit of \$5,000 must be provided.
